

How to download and install Spybot Search & Destroy Version 1.3 (2/25/2005)


- 1) Open your web browser and go to [www.download.com](http://www.download.com)



- 2) In the "SEARCH" bar enter "Spybot Search & Destroy" (without the quotes) and then click on the green "GO >>" button to the right.




- 3) If the search does **not** return something like the example below, then re-check your spelling.
- 4) When the search returns with something like the example below, then click on the green button next to "Download Now" on the far right.




- 5) Once you've clicked on the Download Now button described above, you should get a popup similar to the "File Download" example below. Click on the "Save" button to save it to disk.



- 6) The next dialog box should look similar to the example below. These instructions assume that the file is being saved to your computer's desktop. Once the destination folder (the desktop is also considered a "folder") is set to the "Desktop", then click on the "Save" button.



- 7) You may see a "Downloading" progress bar similar to the one below



- 8) Please notice whether or not the checkbox (Close this dialog box when download completes) is checked on the box shown above. If it is checked, then the box/window will close on its own. Otherwise, you will have to click the "Close" button on the lower right manually.

- 9) Exit your web browser.

- 10) Find the icon on your desktop named "spybotsd13..." (or something similar) as shown, and double-click it to open it and install the program.




- 11) We will assume that you are using English to use during installation, so just click on the "OK" button to proceed (in the example above on the right).


- 12) When the Welcome window is displayed, close your other applications and then click the "Next" button.




13) When the "License Agreement" window is displayed, you need to click on the radio button to the left of "I accept the agreement" and then click on the "Next" button.




14) When the "Select Destination Location" window comes up, leave the specified path as displayed, and click the "Next" button.




- 15) When the "Select Components" window is displayed, it is recommended that you de-select (click to turn off the check boxes) for "Additional languages" and "Skins to change appearance" to keep the install size to a minimum.




- 16) When the "Select Start Menu Folder" window is displayed, just click the "Next" button near the lower right of the window. If you do *not* want a Start Menu entry, then click the check box near the lower left labeled "Don't create a Start Menu folder" first.




- 17) When the "Select Additional Tasks" window is displayed, you may choose (by checking the appropriate box) whether or not you want a desktop icon to run "Spybot Search & Destroy", or a quick launch icon (the small ones just next to the "Start" button on the task bar). If you're not sure, then just click on the "Next" button to proceed.



- 18) At this point, you are ready to actually install the application. Click the "Install" button to proceed.



- 19) During the installation process, you will see the “Installing” window with a progress bar showing the progress. When it is finished, you’ll be presented with the completion window. Both are shown below:



- 20) There are two possible scenarios at this point – depending on the operating system running on your computer.

If you are running some versions of windows, the installation routine may ask you to reboot your computer prior to using the program. At this point, the “**Completing the Spybot – Search & Destroy Setup Wizard**” will present you with one of two possible windows – as shown below and on the next page:

- 21) The “Completing the Spybot – Search & Destroy Setup Wizard” window may present you with a choice of whether or not to start running the program at this point.



- 22) If you wish to start running *Spybot – Search & Destroy*, then just click on the “Finish” button near the lower right of the completion window.

- 23) Alternately, the “**Completing the Spybot – Search & Destroy Setup Wizard**” window may ask you to restart your computer at this point.
- 24) Once your computer has been re-started, you may begin using Spybot Search & Destroy
